SUDAN BEATS WHIPS AND DEPORTS REFUGEES

The whole democratic world should denounce the Sudan for recently rounding up refugees, railroading them to court where the judge sentenced them to cash payment and 40 lashes each . More than forty Ethiopian refugees were immediately whipped and deported. This is done by the Omar Beshir regime which recently received millions of Euros from Britain and the EU to handle refugees and settle them decently.

The refugees were peacefully demonstrating against a high fee for visas and IDs. The demo was broken up brutally by the Sudanese police and dozens detained and subsequently whipped and deported.
